- Standing high on the hill between the villages of Holmbury St Mary and Abinger Common, Belmont is centred on Feldemore, an Arts and Craft grade II listed mansion with beautiful original features

# Boarding



Pupils can board from the age of seven, although this is not a requirement and many use boarding on an ad hoc basis, extending their hours as required.

Many parents find the option of boarding works around family life and work schedules as it can be arranged at short notice. A child may do something different from one day to another and from week to week.

We have a core of weekly boarders who stay at school all week. All pupils leave site on a Friday evening at 4:30pm.

At the end of the school day Belmont becomes the children's home. They can use bicycles, swim, play, have adventures, do indoor or outdoor games as well as get their prep and music practice done and enjoy the camaraderie of their peer group.
